Meaning: Belief in God without belief in religion

Meaning: city in modern day Saudi Arabia, the Prophet Muhammad's (s) place of birth.

Word: Abrahamic religion

Meaning: Religion that traces itself back to the Prophet Abraham (as)

Word: Orthodoxy

Meaning: right creed

Word: Orthopraxy

Meaning: right practice

Meaning: Way of Life, Arabic term for Religion

Word: Ismā'īl

Meaning: Ishmael

Word: Hanif

Meaning: Monotheist follower of Abraham (as) in pre-Islamic Arabia

Word: Hawa

Meaning: the carnal desires of the self

Word: Al-Amīn

Meaning: the truthful one, a name given to the Prophet Muhammad (s) as he was always

truthful.
